Anya Kater from the Ontario Human Rights Commission will share the results of the recent consultation on human rights and rental housing and the implications for seniors' housing providers of the duty to accommodate.

Other topics of discussion will include the new federal housing funding and the opportunities for seniors' housing development, the upcoming provincial affordable housing consultation, provincial policy direction on supportive housing and current operating challenges.
